RESOLUTION 98-1

ESTABLISHES A SYSTEM CAPACITY CHARGE FOR NEW SERVICE CONNECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Westhaven Community Services District Board of Directors recognizes the need to establish a System Capacity Charge for new service connections; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 66013 authorizes "capacity charges" based on "estimated reasonable cost for providing the service for which the fee or charge is imposed"; and

WHEREAS, in circumstances where no new significant system development is anticipated System Capacity Charges can be determined by dividing the Net System Value by the Total Number of Service Connections the system is capable of serving; and

WHEREAS, the Net System Value of the Westhaven Community Services District can be estimated by totaling the value of the District's physical facilities and equipment and then subtracting the value of the long term liabilities; and

WHEREAS, the number of service connections the system is capable of serving can be estimated using historical data comparing system water source capacity to system water consumption; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors of the Westhaven Community Services District hereby establishes a System Capacity Charge, the amount of which is to be determined by dividing the Net System Value by the Total Number of Service Connections the system is capable of serving;
